for Streamlined Rate Relief

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In late October 2022, Rappahannock Electric Cooperative (REC) will be applying to the State Corporation Commission for an increase in its electric delivery rates. A copy of the public notice is enclosed and is being published in newspapers throughout our service territory this week.

REC will be filing an application for streamlined rate relief under the rules set forth by the Virginia Administrative Code (20 VAC 5-200-21) and will request a total revenue increase of approximately 3.90%. The average residential member who uses 1347 kWh per month will see an increase in their total bill of about \$7.78, or approximately 4.1%.


This rate increase is necessary to recover the cost of infrastructure investments that REC has made to its grid, and allow REC to continue to deliver reliable, sustainable service to its members.
